What's Happening?

The Rhode Island Department of Transportation will be reconstructing a new Manville Bridge. The bridge, which connects Cumberland and Lincoln, will be closed and all traffic will be detoured during the construction period. The existing bike path and railroad that run under the bridge will be partially impacted by the construction of this project.

When is it Happening?

Due to the complete reconstruction of the bridge, a detour will be put in place beginning on May 4 of 2020. Traffic signs will be placed in notable locations to assist with vehicle navigation around the detour. The Bridge is estimated to re-open to traffic in the summer of 2021, with full project completion estimated for the Fall of 2021. RIDOT will continue to work with the contractor to evaluate any opportunities to accelerate the reopening of the bridge to two-way traffic.
